SDCU CENTRAL CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

1. There will be four (4) scholarships awarded in the amount of \$300.00 each.
2. Applications must be received on or before the closing date of March 1, 2010, or the application will not be considered.
3. Applicants must have been a member of a credit union in the central chapter for at least one (1) year before the closing date of the application.
4. Applicant must be going to attend an accredited university, college or technical Institute.
5. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, have previously completed high school, or be currently attending a college, university or technical institute.
6. Applicant must complete an application which contains the school they are currently attending (or from which they have most recently attended if they are not currently attending a school) grade point average of the school they are currently attending or most recently attended, school they plan to attend, major they plan to pursue and a brief history of themselves together with a brief explanation of why they feel they are deserving of this scholarship.
7. Applicant must secure a letter of reference from within the present school and submit it to the scholarship committee.
8. Application shall be sent to SDCU Central Chapter, Scholarship Committee at an address which is agreeable to the current committee.
9. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of one member from each credit union within the Central Chapter. The committee shall appoint a Chairman and Secretary from within their membership.
10. Five out of the seven committee members must be present to make a decision. The majority present will decide. A change in policy can be made by majority vote of the members present. A committee member should be present at least one meeting held.
11. The scholarship committee shall select the recipient of the scholarship. The decision shall be made without regard to race, creed, color, national origin or sex.
12. The decision shall be announced at the April Central Chapter meeting.
13. The scholarship check will be made out to the recipient and the school and sent directly to the student.
14. Each credit union office in the Central Chapter shall have a supply of the application forms.
